ACCREDITATION AND REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Step 1: Bureau de Control (Staff FISEC)

- Check/complete form Controle d'Identite Generale (CdIG) including number of participants and accompanying persons (leading for financial wrap up).
- 1.2 Perform identity check of participants.
 - [®] Each country is to present:

forms of identity control civil passport/ID Cards FISEC passports

- FISEC Staff to check shirt numbers for team sports
- FISEC Staff puts down signature and stamp for approval
- FISEC Staff receives competition cards for Athletics and Swimming
- FISEC Staff collects/checks insurance forms (if not available the Head of Delegation will sign a decharge.
- FISEC Staff supplies Games Identity Cards as soon as accreditation is OK.

Step 2: Bureau de Control (Staff FISEC)

- 2.1 Head of Delegation presents form CdIG, already completed by Fisec Staff (on this form the exact number of participants is stated, leading for total amount due)
- 2.2 Treasurer Malta, checks numbers on form versus payment status
- 2.3 Any differences are settled by the delegation/treasurer
- 2.4 Payment can be made in cash (US\$, Euro €)
- 2.5 Form CdIG is signed by Treasurer Malta if all payments have been completed

Step 3: Final Check payment FISEC Tax (Treasurer FISEC – Cor Weets)

- 3.1 Delegate presents form CdIG for final check of numbers of participants to FISEC Treasurer
- 3.2 Any differences are settled
- 3.3 Form CdIG is signed if all payments have been settled

Step 4: Information Desk (Italy)

- 3.1 Information re: hotel accommodation and catering
- 3.2 Information re: Presentation meeting on 02.07.2017
- 3.3 Information re: Technical meetings
- 3.4 Distribution on Information Bulletin containing additional information to Bulletin 0 distributed before.
- 3.4 Hosts/Hostesses (volunteers) to be assigned to each country

Step 5: Bureau de Control (Italy)

- 5.1 Duly signed forms are to be handed over to the Bureau de Control
- 5.2 Sufficient number of copies are made (COJFI, Treasurer 2x, for all OTI's per sport, for President CTI, National Delegate)









MEDICAL ISSUES

The European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)

The European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) allows access to state-provided healthcare in all EEA (European Economic Area) countries and Switzerland often for free or at a reduced cost. However, it is important to have both a European Health Insurance Card and a valid private travel insurance policy. Many insurers now insist you hold an European Health Insurance Card to be covered, this varies from insurer to insurer please check with your insurance company. The card <u>is not</u> an alternative to travel insurance. It will not cover any private medical healthcare or things such as mountain rescue or lost or stolen property.



The Brazilian, Indian and Palestine contingents <u>are not covered in</u> any way by the EHIC.

Medical coverage at the hotels

All hotels have a system for medical assistance in place and contingents are encouraged to contact reception in the event of medical emergencies at the hotel. Contingents are also requested to contact the FISEC Secretariat at Stadio Teghil for further assistance in these situation.










MAP OF LIGNANO – VENUES, HOTELS, EVENTS AND SECRETARIAT

The Youth Forum saw its conception during the Malta Games 2004. Selected athletes from each country meet together to share and exchange ideas, opinions and the cultural traditions of their particular country. The Forum will be held on Tuesday, 4th July at the Stadio G. Teghil. All countries are reminded to choose a boy and a girl from their contingent to represent their delegations during this exchange of ideas.











THE FAIR PLAY AWARDS

After discussing with youngsters from all the different participating countries, in the Youth Forum 2009 in Portimao, 2010 in Tours and 2011 in Lisbon, the most important things for them were:

- 1. doing the best that you can
- 2. being part of a team (friendship + having fun)
- 3. feeling Fair Play for everyone.

The discussion gave evidence that Fair Play = a universal language

Resulting in "Everyone is a winner"!

The most important arguments for a positive evaluation for the Fair Play Awards:

- 1. Positive behaviour towards the other athletes (participants)
 - = no cheating
 - = no aggression
 - = accept defeat
- 2. Positive behaviour to the referees
 - = accept decisions
 - = own up to mistakes (be correct / respect the truth)
- 3. General behaviour to the organisation
 - = respect for all the organizers
 - = respect for all the materials
 - = being polite, thinking on friendship!!!

Based on all these principals we like to continue organising before and after the matches during the competition, the circle of Fair Play before the match and the lane of honour after the match.

Based on all these principals we are following the evaluation system for the Fair Play Awards, for each sport, for girls and boys.









Team Sports:

- After 2 days of competition and at the end of the competitions there are given points by:
 - the referees (in group) for both teams
 - those responsible from the Organising Committee (COJFI) for both teams
 - the OTI for both teams
- according to the upon principles you give a score from 5 (the best) to 1
- in case of exceptional gests of fair play it will influence of course the score for this team (more or less) and we ask to notice this on the evaluation form with some comments

Individual Sports:

- 2 times during the Games there are given points by:
 - those responsible from the Organising Committee (COJFI) for each team
 - the OTI for each team
- according to the upon principles you give a score from 5 (the best) to 1
- in case of exceptional gests of fair play it will influence of course the score for this team (more or less) and we ask to notice this on the evaluation form with some comments

The OTI gives the score sheets to the president or secretary of the CTI (after 2 days of competition and after 4 days of competition; the last day of the Games you can join the results for the teams who had competition the last day)! In case of exceptional gests they are noted specially.

Last day before the closing ceremony there will be a meeting with:

- president and secretary CIRPP
- all the OTI's
- president and secretary CTI
- representative(s) of the Bureau.

They will do a deliberation after having counted all the day scores and having made a report with the exceptional gests.

During the Closing Ceremony the president of the CTI will explain in a few words the arguments for taking decision for the Fair Play Awards and in case of exceptional gests!

The mooring complex (marina) of Lignano is the largest in Italy and among the largest in Europe, having more than 5,000 berths.






